Our future plans include: purchasing a permanent camera for the church so that live streaming into the hall and on Facebook will be more professional, and adding touchless Holy Water fonts.

Our Ministries are slowly coming back to life and there are plans for, a one day Vacation Bible School, Bake Sales, movie nights, our rummage sale, and hopefully the Knights monthly breakfast. But that all depends on what happens in the next few months.
